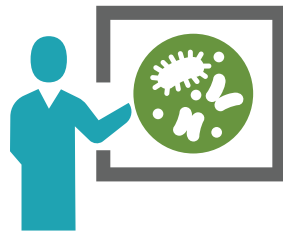


ABRCMS is...
